

# Chhattisgarh: In Assembly, BJP demands CM's resignation over nude protest

**RAIPUR, JULY 19 /--** The BJP in the Chhattisgarh Assembly on Wednesday slammed the Congress government over a protest by a group of nude men in capital Raipur and demanded the resignation of Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel, saying the incident has brought disrepute to the state.

BJP MLAs created uproar on the issue in the House leading to the adjournment of proceedings for five minutes. The opposition legislators were also briefly suspended after they trooped into the well, sloganeering against the government and demanding the release of the arrested nude protesters. A group of men without clothes staged a protest in Raipur on Tuesday demanding action against people who allegedly got government jobs using fake caste certificates.

The police arrested 29 protesters as they marched towards the State Legislative Assembly. Raising the issue during the Zero Hour, when members can raise issues of urgent public importance, Leader of Opposition Narayan Chandel and many opposition members called the nude protest has brought infamy to the state in the country as well as abroad. BJP's Ajay Chandrakar, Shivratna Sharma and Brijmohan Agrawal and Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) members Indu Banjare and Keshav Chandra were among those who raised the issue. They said the protesters had been seeking action for a long time but the state govern-

ment did not pay heed to their demands which compelled them to stage a demonstration without clothes, the BJP members said. Instead of taking action against people holding fake caste certificates, the state government jailed the protesters who were fighting for

their rights, they said, demanding discussion on the issue by moving an adjournment motion notice. The BJP demanded that a high-powered committee be formed to look into the issue of getting jobs on the basis of bogus certificates. Some treasury bench members countered the opposition members, claiming that people with fake caste certificates were appointed during the previous BJP government. Amid pandemonium, the chair adjourned the proceeding for five minutes. After the proceedings resumed, Chandel again raised the issue and claimed more than 1,000 people holding fake caste certificates have been work-

ing in government departments. "The protesters had already informed the administration about the nude protest. The government should have at least thought about why they were compelled to hold such a demonstration. The CM has no morality to remain on the post and he should immediately resign," Chandel said. Home Minister Tamradhwaj Sahu informed the House about the protest and the action taken against the protesters. Speaker Charan Das Mahant then rejected the adjournment motion notice following which BJP members, dissatisfied with the reply of the home minister, trooped into the well of the House sloganeering against the government. The BJP MLAs were automatically suspended as per the Assembly rules. However, their suspension was revoked within a few minutes by the Speaker. (PTI)

## People with bipolar disorder 6 times likelier to die from suicide, accidents or violence: Study

**NEW DELHI, JULY 19 /--** People having bipolar disorder are 6 times more likely to die prematurely from external causes such as accidents, violence, and suicide than those not having the condition, according to new research published in BMJ Mental Health.

They are also twice as likely to die from physical illnesses such as heart and/or respiratory diseases, or cancer, with alcohol contributing majorly towards it, the Finnish population-based study found. People with bipolar disorder are known to face a heightened risk of premature death. However, the drivers behind this, especially the role of physical illnesses, were unclear, which this study aimed to understand, researchers from Nivanniemi Hospital, Finland, and other institutes from Sweden and the UK said. They tracked 47,018 people with bipolar disorder, with an average age of 38 years at the start of the monitoring period (2004-2018). Their data was picked from nationwide medical and social insurance registers. More than half of those identified (57 per cent) were women. Overall, 3,300 (7 per cent) died over the monitoring period compared with 141,536 deaths in the general population excluding people having the condition, the researchers found and calculated the heightened risk of death to be 6 times due to external causes and 2 times from physical illnesses. Average age at death was 50 years and nearly two-thirds of the deaths were in men.

61 per cent of the 3,300 deaths (2027) were physically caused and 39 per cent (1273) were externally caused. Of the physically caused deaths, alcohol was found to cause the most at 29 per cent, or 595 deaths. Of these, liver disease accounted for nearly half, followed by accidental alcohol poisoning and alcohol dependence. Remaining physically caused deaths were found to be caused by heart disease and stroke (27 per cent), cancer (22 per cent), respiratory disease (4 per cent), diabetes (2 per cent) and other causes (15-16 per cent). Of the externally caused deaths, suicide caused the most (58 per cent). Of these, nearly half were caused by overdose of prescribed mental health medications, including those used for treating bipolar disorder. "A balanced consideration between therapeutic response, potential serious long term somatic (physical) side effects of different medicines, and risk of cause-specific premature mortality is needed, especially in younger persons," the authors wrote in their paper. "Targeting preventive interventions for substance abuse will likely reduce the mortality gap both due to external causes and somatic causes. Suicide prevention remains a priority, and better awareness of the risk of overdose and other poisonings is warranted," they said. (PTI)

## A special tomb being readied for Chandy in his Parish church

**KOTTAYAM, JULY 19 /--** The mortal remains of Kerala's two-time Chief Minister Oommen Chandy, who died in Bengaluru on Tuesday, will be laid to rest at a special tomb on an exclusive area of his village church, where priests are buried.

As preparations are on in full swing for his funeral on Thursday, a special tomb is being built for Chandy in an exclusive area on the church premises instead of his family vault in the cemetery. The authorities of the St George Orthodox Church, popularly known as "Puthuppally Palli" in local parlance, have decided to change their decades-old practice of burying dead laymen in the church cemetery or in their family vaults there for the Congress stalwart. The church committee decided to change the practice as a mark of respect for "Kunjoonju", as he was known among his villagers and admirers. Church vicar Varghese Varghese said the

decision was taken considering the immense contributions given by Chandy to the parish and to the church in these decades. "The decision was taken to lay him to rest on the church ground where the remains of the late priests were buried, considering his virtues and the contributions he made to the parish and the church," he said. As per the common practice, the mortal remains of an ordinary believer are being buried in the cemetery and those of priests in an exclusive area located north or south of the church, he said.

"The tomb for Chandy is being readied adjacent to that of the priests. The general feeling of the parish is that his tomb will remain a permanent memorial on the church premises," the priest said. Recalling Chandy's contributions to the parish, he said the former Chief Minister is one of the persons who have contributed the most to its modernisation and development. Since his younger

days, Chandy had been very much active in the youth movement, Sunday school activities and prayer meetings in the church, and it had paved the way for his growth as a public activist, MLA, minister, and the Chief Minister of the state, the vicar added. Bidding adieu to the state capital Thiruvananthapuram, the mortal remains of Chandy - who died in Bengaluru a day ago - was taken to Kottayam, the stronghold of the Congress stalwart, on Wednesday morning. His body was taken to Kottayam by road in a specially modified low-floor bus covered in garlands and pictures of Chandy and packed with party leaders and workers. Arrangements have been made at the Thirunakkara Ground here for the public to pay homage to Chandy and thereafter, his body will be shifted to his home in Puthuppally. (PTI)

## Pilot, husband beaten up by mob for thrashing minor domestic help in Delhi's Dwarka

### Airline derosters her, says matter is being probed

**NEW DELHI, JULY 19 /--** A 10-year-old girl working as a domestic help at a couple's house in southwest Delhi's Dwarka was allegedly beaten up by them on Wednesday, following which a group of agitated people manhandled the duo.

The accused -- Kaushik Bagchi (36) and Poornima Bagchi (33) -- have been arrested in connection with the incident, they said. Police said the woman works as a pilot with IndiGo while her husband is employed with the ground staff in another private airline. After the incident came to light, the couple was confronted by the victim's relatives and others who also manhandled them. The minor girl was employed at the couple's house through the victim's relative who also works in a nearby house, they added.

In a purported video, the alleged couple could be seen manhandled and beaten up by a mob. Some of the women were also seen slapping and pulling the hair of the accused woman who was in her

uniform. Poornima was heard apologising in the video while Kaushik was seen shielding her from the agitated mob saying that "she would die...Leave her...". An elderly man intervened and then the crowd dispersed. Deputy Commissioner of Police (Dwarka) M Harsha Vardhan said that around 9 am, information was received at Dwarka South police station regarding the mistreatment of a child who worked as a domestic help.

It was found that a 10-year-old girl has been working at the couple's house for the last two months. The minor was beaten up by the duo on Wednesday and her relative witnessed this.

After the matter came to notice, a crowd gathered outside the couple's residence. They confronted the couple and also manhandled them,

the DCP said. The minor girl was medically examined and counselled by a counsellor, he added. According to police, the victim has injuries on her eyes and also has burn marks on her body. "We have registered a case under sections 323 (voluntarily causing hurt), 324 (voluntarily causing hurt by dangerous weapons or means), 342 (wrongful confinement) and 370 (buying or disposing of any person as a slave) of the Indian Penal Code, Child Labour Act and section 75 Juvenile Justice Act," the DCP said.

No allegations of sexual harassment have been levelled by the victim, police said. When asked if an action would be taken against those who manhandled the couple, the officer said that the action will be taken as per the complaint. IndiGo on Wednesday said it has derostered the accused pilot. Without specifically mentioning about the case, an IndiGo spokesperson said it is aware of a video circulating on social media that allegedly involves an individual employed by the airline. "We are currently investigating the matter. Meanwhile, the employee has been derostered from official duties," the spokesperson said in a statement. (PTI)
