

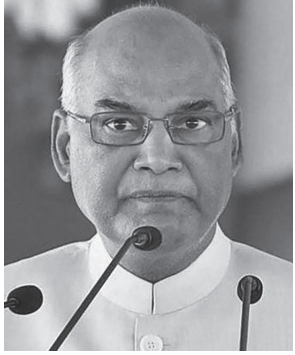

Haryana Police warn people about fake electricity bill messages

CHANDIGARH, MAY 15 /--/ Haryana Police have issued an advisory requesting people not to share any personal information in response to messages being sent to them by cyber fraudsters regarding unpaid electricity bills.

Cautioning the people to be aware of such scammers, a Haryana Police spokesperson on Sunday said a latest trend of cybercrime has come to the fore in which cyber fraudsters have started duping people in the name of unpaid electricity bills. "They send text messages pretending to be from trusted sources to get the targets to click on links that install malware to steal personal and banking details. We are constantly trying to help the people by advising them to refrain from falling into the trap of such scammers," he said. Explaining the modus operandi, the spokesperson informed that the fraudsters send a text message to their targets, saying your electricity will be disconnected as your previous month's bill was not updated and ask them to call on a phone number.

"Once the victims make contact, the fraudsters try to convince them to share their bank account details for the purpose of verifying previous payments. They also ask them to install remote access applications like Anydesk and Team Viewer," he said. Once the victims share the information, the fraudsters get access to their bank accounts, he said. Suggesting people to be extremely cautious, the spokesperson advised them never to share their personal information or phone number unless they are sure that the person contacting them is an authorised staffer of the power company. "Avoid downloading software from unofficial sources and also avoid providing personal or financial information in response to the unsolicited text or at a website linked to the message. People should also avoid clicking on links in suspicious text, which could install malware on their device," he said. "If, however, one still becomes a victim, any such incident should be immediately reported on cybercrime. (PTI)

Detailed forensic probe on to identify cause of recent bus fire in J&K's Reasi: NIA

JAMMU, MAY 15 /--/ National Investigation Agency (NIA) on Sunday said a detailed forensic probe is continuing to identify the reason for the recent cause of a fire in a passenger bus near Katra town, the base camp for the pilgrims visiting Mata Vaishno Devi shrine in Reasi district of Jammu and Kashmir.

Four persons were killed and 24 others injured on Friday when a fire ripped apart the moving bus, mostly carrying devotees, near Nomai, about three

kilometers from Katra, shortly after it left for Jammu from the base camp. A team of NIA inspected the wreckage of the bus on Saturday and collected samples during their one-and-a-half hour stay at the scene. NIA has extended all requisite assistance to J&K Police in the investigation of the case of passenger bus catching fire near Katra on Friday.

Detailed forensic probe is continuing to identify the reasons for the cause of fire, the agency said in a tweet. Though the survivors and

the people residing in the vicinity of the incident spoke about hearing a sound of an explosion in the bus, Additional Director General (ADG) of Police, Jammu zone, Mukesh Singh on Friday said initial probe does not point to use of any explosive.

"The bus caught fire on its way from Katra to Jammu. The cause of fire is not confirmed yet", Singh had told newsmen at the scene of the incident, adding a forensic team is looking into the cause of fire. (PTI)

As his remark on Char Dham deaths triggers row, BJP leader says video shows half-truth

DEHRADUN, MAY 15 /--/ An Uttarakhand BJP leader, whose remark purportedly blaming Covid-related complications for the deaths during this year's Char Dham yatra have triggered a row, on Sunday said he was only quoting officials.

In a video that surfaced on social media on Saturday, Uttarakhand BJP spokesperson Shadab Shams was heard saying that pilgrims were hiding health issues and undertaking the arduous journey in the belief that they would attain "moksha" even if something happened to them. As the video created a controversy, Congress leaders of the state demanded an apology from Shams and accused him of hurting religious sentiments. They claimed that by making remarks like these, the BJP leader was only trying to hide the mismanagement of the yatra. Responding to the

allegations, Shams said: "The video clip that went viral shows only half-truth, which is more harmful than a lie. When asked by news portals about rising pilgrim deaths on way to the shrines, I quoted officials who had said that mostly the pilgrims with Covid history were dying as they were hiding their complications from the authorities in the belief that even if something happened to them en route to the temples, they would be absolved of their sins and attain moksha." It was a statement made by the officials, and he was only quoting them, the BJP leader asserted. "My intention was only to convey to pilgrims that they should not hide complications like breathlessness, high blood pressure and blood sugar from the authorities just because they are keen to visit the temples. All I

wanted to say was that people should strictly follow the chief minister's advisory and travel only if they are fit," he said.

"However, if my statement has hurt sentiments, I extend my sincerest apologies," Shams said. The state government has made good arrangements for pilgrims on the Char Dham yatra route, the BJP leader said, and asked the opposition not to create fear in the minds of the people coming for the pilgrimage. Around 23 pilgrims have died on their way to the temples so far since the start of the Char Dham yatra on May 3. (PTI)

Akhilesh targets BJP gov't over removal of UP police chief

LUCKNOW, MAY 15 /--/ Samajwadi Party president Akhilesh Yadav on Sunday accused the Adityanath government of lowering the morale of the Uttar Pradesh Police by removing Mukul Goel as its chief. Goel was, on May 11, removed from the post of Director General of Police on charge of inefficiency and neglecting his work and appointed as the civil defence department. Later DS Chauhan was made acting DGP of the state. "Removing the DGP of UP on the allegation that he used to disregard government work, did not take interest in departmental work and was inefficient is a very childish excuse. It has lowered the morale of the police force, Akhilesh said in a tweet in Hindi. He asked whether Goel's eligibility was not checked at the time of his appointment.

Goel, a 1987-batch IPS officer, was appointed the Uttar Pradesh police chief in June last year. Before that, he had served as an additional director general of the Border Security Force. "Was his eligibility (of Goel) not checked at the time of his appointment, so those who selected him are

also guilty," the SP president and former chief minister said. Born in Muzaffarnagar, Goel has a B.Tech degree in Electrical Engineering from the Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi. (PTI)

Cong to field those below 50 in half of seats in LS, state polls from 2024

To fix retirement age in legislatures

UDAIPUR, MAY 15 /--/ The Congress on Sunday said starting 2024 Lok Sabha elections, half of its tickets will be given to those below 50 years of age and retirement age will be fixed for those in Parliament, state legislatures and other elected posts.

The bold decisions are part of the Congress 'Nav Sankalp' declaration that was adopted at the end of the three-day 'Chintan Shivir' here, indicating that the party has chosen to put its weight behind the young leadership after a prolonged old-versus-new tussle. The exit of several young leaders from the Congress in recent years had been attributed to the party's old guard failing

to address the aspirations of the so-called 'gen-next' leaders. While adopting the 'Nav Sankalp' declaration, the party said exactly 80 years ago, in the year 1942, Mahatma Gandhi gave the slogan of "Quit India" and in 2022, the slogan of "Jodo India" (Unite India) should be adopted now.

The Congress also decided to bring a Constitutional amendment to provide 33 percent reservation for women in Parliament, Legislative Assemblies and legislative councils and get it passed at the earliest to ensure the empowerment of women so that females in every category should get the benefit of proportionate

reservation. The party also resolved to raise the demands of SCs/STs/minorities and OBCs across the country through the organisation, and as a first step, it would press for an SC-ST sub-plan with legal recognition in the budgets of the central and provincial governments. At the organisational level, 50 percent of the posts should go to colleagues below 50 years of age. The youth group also concluded that a retirement age be fixed in Parliament, legislatures, legislative council and all elected posts.

In future party governments, 50 percent of people below 50 years of age should occupy positions.

More experienced people should be used for strengthening the organisation. Beginning with the 2024 parliamentary elections, at least 50 percent of party tickets be granted to those below 50 years of age in parliament, legislatures, legislative councils and other levels, the resolution said.

The 'Nav Sankalp' resolution adopted at the Udaipur Shivir also stated that youth party leaders should play a leading role and be active in non-political activities like youth festivals, cultural events, sports events, youth parliament, town hall meetings and blood donation, etc. (PTI)

Rahul Bhat's killing: LG orders probe into use of force against protesting Kashmiri Pandits

SRINAGAR, MAY 15 /--/ Jammu and Kashmir Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha on Sunday ordered an inquiry into the use of force against the Kashmiri Pandit employees who were protesting the killing of Rahul Bhat.

Protests were held at several places in J&K against the killing as well as against the failure of the administration to provide security to the Kashmiri Pandit employees. Police used batons and tear smoke shells at Sheikhpora in Budgam on Friday to quell the protest. The government has ordered an inquiry into Bhat's killing and a SIT has been constituted. Bhat's murder

was a targeted killing and an attempt has been made to create an atmosphere of fear and terror. He was a very good employee. We have constituted a SIT over the issue. The SHO has been attacked. The SIT will investigate all the angles,' Sinha said here. He said the SIT will also inquire into the use of force on the protestors. The force which was used will also be investigated. In one week's time, their posting will be done in safe and secure places. They have some other grievances and those will also be looked into. We understand their pain and difficulties, the LG said, adding, the administration will make arrangements for

full security wherever they live. The LG also said he has directed the administration that there is no need to use force. Bhat, who had got the job of a clerk under the special employment package for Kashmiri Pandits in 2010-11, was gunned down by terrorists inside the tehsil office in Chadoora town on Thursday. He appealed to the Kashmiri Pandit employees to keep patience for some time, assuring them that all their issues will be resolved. Sinha said some people were trying to disturb peace in Kashmir, but the administration is taking the issue very seriously. I appeal the politicians and

political parties as well as common people that this is the time to stay together so that the peaceful atmosphere remains. Some people are trying to disturb the atmosphere, but I want to tell them that their attempts will not succeed. Two foreign terrorists involved in the incident have been killed and the police force is after the others, he said.

The LG also said the administration is sensitive to the issue and will make every attempt to resolve their issues. I appeal all the political parties that to issue an appeal for social boycott of such elements involved in these (killings) incidents, Sinha said. (PTI)

Rajasthan trader's killing: Wife accuses local MLA of being involved in attack

JAIPUR, MAY 15 /--/ Wife of a trader killed by unidentified assailants in Nagaur has accused Rajasthan government's deputy chief whip Mahendra Choudhary and his associates of being involved in the attack.

Choudhary, however, termed the allegation baseless and politically motivated. Jaipal Poonia, a salt trader, was shot dead by around six men in broad daylight in Nawar town in Nagaur district on Saturday. A case against Choudhary and seven others was lodged at Nawar Police Station under Indian Penal Code sections 302 (murder) and 120B (criminal conspiracy) following a complaint by the family of Poonia, police said. In the

FIR lodged by the victim's wife, she alleged that on the directions of Choudhary, who is also the MLA from Nawar, his brother Moti Singh, Moolchand Saini, Virendra Saini and others killed her husband. My husband left home at 10.30 am for court on Saturday but returned at 11 am, saying that the hearing would be held at 12.30 pm. While having lunch, he told me that the MLA and others are trying to implicate him in a false case. He said he was getting threats and may be killed. Poonia's wife alleged in the complaint. According to police, Poonia has several criminal cases registered against him. Reacting to the allegation, Choudhary said,

all the charges are baseless and politically motivated.

Meanwhile, Nagaur MP and Rashtriya Loktantrik Party leader Hanuman Beniwal has demanded a CBI probe in the case, saying the incident shows that there is no fear of police among criminals. The MP alleged that in places like Nawar and Kuchaman, police officers along with the local MLA and his family are running a parallel government, as a result of which there is a

steady increase in heinous crimes. He said due to the failure of the government and weak administrative system in Rajasthan, the common man is feeling unsafe. (PTI)
